The good news is that the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has partnered with East Irondequoit School District to serve **FREE** meals. It's food that's in, while school is out. The other good news is that there are **no income requirements and no registration necessary**. The Summer Food Program is fully funded by the USDA. **Any child 18 and under may come to eat**. Meals must be eaten on site and parents/guardians may also purchase a meal for a nominal fee. Transportation will not be provided to participate in the Summer Food Program.
