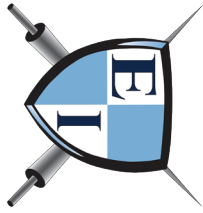

## How to Vote by Absentee Ballot

Residents unable to vote because of disabilities, illness, travel or other reasons listed as valid under the NYS education law, may request applications for absentee ballots by contacting the District Clerk at 339-1210 or by visiting our website: [www.eastiron.org/voterinfo](http://www.eastiron.org/voterinfo). To receive a ballot in the mail residents must file their application with the district clerk no later than Tuesday, May 11, 2021 or to pick up their ballot in person they must file their application through Monday, May 17, 2021. Ballots must be returned to the Administrative Office no later than 5 pm on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. No ballots can be accepted at the polling place. Ballots received later than 5 pm, on Tuesday, May 18, cannot be accepted under State Education Law, regardless of the postmark date.

## Voter Qualifications

East Irondequoit residents are eligible to vote if you are a U.S. citizen; have lived in the district for at least 30 days prior to the vote; and are at least 18 years old by the day of the vote.

You do not have to be registered to be eligible to vote, but proof of residency is required. A driver's license, tax return, police i.d., or personal check are all acceptable forms of residency.

## What's on the Ballot?

### School Budget:

On May 18th, district residents will vote on a proposed \$86,563,388 budget for the 2021-22 school year.

### Board of Education Candidates:

Residents will vote to fill three seats on Board of Education, each elected candidate will serve a three year term. Candidates running for the board are Patricia Storm, Stacey Beaumont, Doreen Swan, Lucinda Scalia, and Donald Markham.
