**Approval of Skyview Pilot
Agreement Revision**

PILOT

WHEREAS, the District previously gave its support for the application of 1733 Ridge Road, LLC for a PILOT agreement between 1733 Ridge Rd, LLC ("Company") and Imagine Monroe (formerly named as the County of Monroe Industrial Development Authority) for tax parcels 092.05-1-86; 092.05-1-85.111; 092.05-1-85.2; 092.05-1-87.1; 092.05-1-9; 092.05-1-20; 092.05-1-84; 092.05-1-16; 092.05-1-17; 092.05-1-18; and 092.05-1-19; and

WHEREAS, the Company requested that due to the size of the project, the PILOT agreement payment schedule previously approved by the District be applied individually to each tax parcel under the PILOT as such tax parcel was renovated and received a certificate of occupancy; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that the redevelopment of the former Irondequoit Mall lies in the best interest of the District and the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Board supports the adjustment to the PILOT payment schedule to apply such schedule to each individual tax parcel as such tax parcel receives a certificate of occupancy, provided that all tax parcels under the PILOT shall be subject to the PILOT payment schedule no later than March 1, 2024 regardless of whether such tax parcels have received a certificate of occupancy.
2. The Board hereby authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to provide a copy of this resolution to Imagine Monroe and sign any and all documents necessary to indicate the District's support.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
