## WELCOME TO SECOND GRADE AT HELENDALE ROAD SCHOOL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2019 - 2020

Here is a General Supply List of items that your child will need for Second Grade. These supplies can be purchased at minimal expense by taking advantage of the early back to school summer sales. Some supplies will be for community use. These supplies are recommended, not required. No labeling of items is necessary.

The general items needed for Second Grade next year are:

- ❖ 1 dozen **SHARPENED** yellow pencils (made in the USA)
- ❖ 1 plastic supply box, approximately 8 ½ " x 5 ½ " or a zipper supply bag
- ❖ 1 box of Crayola broad-line or fine-line markers (optional)
- ❖ 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- ❖ 2 plain pocket folders (one each red, blue)
- ❖ 1 plastic folder for a "Take Home" folder
- ❖ 1 **PLAIN** spiral bound notebook – wide ruled
- ❖ 1 package glue sticks
- ❖ 2 dark colored dry erase markers (can be purchased at the Dollar store)
- ❖ The "How I Get Home From School" form enclosed

Additional items may be needed throughout the year.

**Please fill out and return the Free and Reduced School Meals application that will be mailed to you in August.**

Second Grade students will have lockers outside their classrooms. For this reason, please make sure your child's backpack does not have wheels. Each locker is only 12 inches by 12 inches. This type of backpack will not fit into our lockers and is also difficult for your children to maneuver on the bus and through the hallways. Also, please do not buy any locker accessories because they are not allowed in Second Grade.
