

Minutes of the Annual District Meeting of the East Irondequoit Board of Education, June 16, 2020 at 5:00 p.m., in the cafeteria of Laurelton-Pardee Intermediate School, 600 Pardee Road.

Due to Executive Orders issued by Governor Andrew Cuomo due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the vote was conducted entirely by absentee ballots. The hand-counting of the ballots started on June 16, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. The hand-counting was live streamed via Ensemble beginning at 5:00 p.m. and ending at 9:00 p.m.

The proposition to be voted on appeared on the ballots as shown on the sample ballot appended.

Absentee ballots were counted and verified by eighteen Election Inspectors, Kristen Munger, Chairperson and Chief Inspector, the District Clerk, School Attorney Joseph Shields, and Deputy Superintendent John Abbott.

At 8:59 p.m. Kristen Munger, Chairperson and Chief Inspector of the vote, announced the results via the live stream video.
